



Job-Related Fraud Notice

Recruiters from Everpure (formerly Pure Storage) will **always** contact you using an email format of name@everpuredata.com or name@purestorage.com. Do not respond to any emails from an address where the domain name "everpuredata.com" or "purestorage.com" contains a misspelling. If you received suspicious inquiries from "*representatives of Everpure / Pure / Pure Storage*," including any of the items listed below regarding job opportunities, it is fraudulent and should be ignored.

Signs of Fraudulent Job-Related Activity

- Communications coming from personal email accounts or messaging apps (e.g. Apple FaceTime, Google Hangouts or Meet; Gmail, Hotmail, Outlook, Yahoo email addresses; WhatsApp, Skype, Signal, Telegram, etc.)
- Requests for Social Security Number, financial information, or other personal sensitive information
- Failure to provide clear or accurate job descriptions, including not providing a specific location for the job
- Promises implying you can get rich quickly
- Request to cash fraudulent checks and monetary transfers
- Requests to send money to Everpure / Pure Storage, for any reason. Everpure will never ask for job applicants or hires to send money (including using apps like PayPal, Venmo, or any crypto-currency platform)

Recommended Steps to Take When Subjected to Job-Related Fraud

- Immediately stop all interactions with the fraudulent party.
- Report this activity to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) through their [Report Fraud](https://reportfraud.ftc.gov) website (reportfraud.ftc.gov).
- If you have lost money, report it to your local law enforcement.
