### COPYRIGHT INFORMATION

Everpure, Inc. (“Everpure”) respects the intellectual property rights of others and expects the same in return. This includes respecting copyrighted works. Below is some helpful information regarding copyrights and the process to send Everpure a Notice of Copyright Infringement. ### WHAT IS A COPYRIGHT?

Copyright law protects “original works of authorship fixed in a tangible medium of expression.” Examples of copyrighted works include source code, music, collateral, videos, photos, web content, manuals, papers, signage, etc. There is also a copyrighted work called a “derivative work.” A derivative work is based upon a pre-existing work in which the pre-existing work is changed, condensed, recast, transformed, adapted, or embellished.

### WHAT IS COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT?

Copyright infringement occurs when any one or more of the following rights is violated: (1) reproduction; (2) adaptation; (3) distribution to the public; (4) performance in public; or (5) display in public. Copyright infringement can also take place when a new or modification of an existing work, known as a derivative work, is created from a copyrighted work. If the preexisting or underlying work is protected by copyright law, one who wishes to exploit the derivative work must obtain a license from the owner of the copyright in the underlying work or works. Given this, any modification of any Everpure copyrighted works without explicit permission could constitute infringement.

### EVERPURE COPYRIGHT POLICY

You may not make any unauthorized reproduction or engage in distribution of any Everpure copyrighted works, which include, but are not limited to copyrighted works such as computer software (including source and object code), publications, books, online curricular, web content, diagrams, videos, audio publications, photos, testing materials, exams, text, images, and graphics published by Everpure or any third party Everpure partner or customer in any format. It is Everpure’s policy to enforce its copyrights against any third-party infringer. To ensure that you do not infringe on any Everpure or third-party Everpure partner or customer copyrighted works, do not, without express written permission from Everpure, engage in any of the following:

1. Do not directly or indirectly copy, reproduce, or distribute any Everpure copyrighted works (including webpages) or any part of the text or graphics from those works without written permission from Everpure.

### SUBMITTING A NOTICE OF COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT TO PURE (DMCA NOTICE)

Please note that whether or not Everpure disables access to or removes unauthorized uses of copyrighted content, Everpure may make a good faith attempt to forward the written notification, including the complainant's contact information, to the person who posted the content and/or take other reasonable steps to notify the person that Everpure has received notice of an alleged violation of intellectual property rights or other content violation. It is also our policy, in appropriate circumstances and in our discretion, to disable and/or terminate the accounts of people, or groups, who infringe or repeatedly infringe the rights of others or otherwise post unlawful content.

### **SUBMITTING A COUNTER-NOTICE CLAIM TO PURE REGARDING COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT**

If you believe that a Notice of Copyright Infringement has been improperly submitted against you, you may submit a Counter-Notice, pursuant to Sections 512(g)(2) and (3) of the Digital Millennium Copyright Act to Everpure's Copyright Agent at [copyrights@purestorage.com](mailto:copyrights@purestorage.com) or mail a hardcopy notice to the Everpure mailing address specified above. Using a similar format to the example above, please include the following information in your Counter-Notice:

1. Your physical or electronic signature;
2. Identification of the material removed or to which access has been disabled;
3. A statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good faith belief that removal or disablement of the material was a mistake or that the material was misidentified;
4. Your full name, your email address, your mailing address, and a statement that you consent to the jurisdiction of the Federal District court (i) in the judicial district where your address is located if the address is in the United States, or (ii) located in the Northern District of California (Santa Clara County), if your address is located outside the United States, and that you will accept service of process from the complainant submitting the notice or his/her authorized agent.

### **ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT COPYRIGHT INFORMATION**

Any Notice of Copyright Infringement or Counter-Notice you submit must be truthful and must be submitted under penalty of perjury. A false Notice of Copyright Infringement or Counter-Notice may give rise to personal liability. Given this, you may want to seek the advice of your own attorney before submitting a notice or a counter-notice.
